“(i) That a writ in the nature of mandamus may kindly be issued directing the respondent more specifically respondent No. 3 to consider the candidature of the petitioner for admission to B.Ed. Training Course for the session 2011-11 against C&V category against a vacant seat.”

2. On 29th July, 2011, this Court passed the following
order in CMP No. 7558 of 2011:

“Learned Deputy Advocate General seeks time to get instructions. It is made clear that in case there is available vacancy under the quota under C&V, the same shall be allotted to the petitioner.”

3. The learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the interim order, no further order is required to be passed. Therefore, the said interim order is made absolute and the writ petition stands disposed of in terms of the said order, so also the pending application(s), if any.
