PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offence punishable under Sections 420 and 506 (ii) I.P.C., in Crime No.Not known of 2011 on the file of the respondent police and hence, seeks anticipatory bail.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner is an innocent person and he has been falsely implicated in this case and hence, he prays for enlargement on anticipatory bail.

3. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor would submit that no case has been registered against the petitioner.

4. Considering the submission of the learned Additional Public Prosecutor, I am not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner. However, I am inclined to give a direction to the respondent not to harass the petitioner under the guise of petition enquiry. The respondent is directed to follow the dictum laid down



in ***D.K.Basu Vs. State of West Bengal*** reported in ***AIR (1997) SC 610***.

5. With the above direction, this Criminal Original petition is disposed of.
