PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioners apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offences punishable under sections 323, 355 and 506(i) of I.P.C., in Crime No. Not Known of 2011 on the file of the respondent police and hence, seek anticipatory bail.

2.The learned counsel for the petitioners would submit that the petitioners are innocent persons and they have been falsely implicated in this case and hence, he prays for enlargement on anticipatory bail.

3.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor would submit that no case has been registered against the petitioners.

4.Considering the submission of the learned Additional Public Prosecutor, I am not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners. However, I am inclined to give a direction to the respondent not to harass the petitioners under the guise of petition enquiry. The respondent is directed to follow the dictum laid down in **D.K.Basu Vs. State of West Bengal** reported in **AIR (1997)SC 610**.

5.With the above direction, this Criminal Original Petition is disposed of.
