ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioners apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged commission of offences punishable under Sections 420, 448 and 506(ii) IPC., and hence, seek anticipatory bail.

2.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor (Crl.side) would submit that on the basis of the complaint given by the de-facto complainant, no case has been registered only petition enquiry is pending.

3.Considering the rival submissions made on either side, the respondent is directed not to harass the petitioners. The respondent is directed to follow the procedure contemplated under D.K.Basu Vs. State of West Bengal reported in AIR(1997) SC 610 under the guise of enquiry.

With the above observation, the petition is disposed of.
