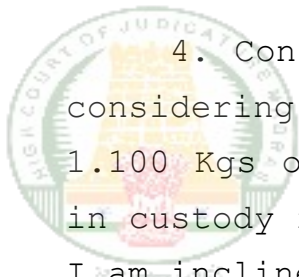
PETITION FOR BAIL Under Sec. 439 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner is arrayed as an accused and he was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 22.09.2011 for the alleged offence punishable under Section 8 (c) r/w 20(b) (ii) (B) of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, in Crime No.105 of 2011 on the file of the respondent police and hence, seeks bail.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner is an innocent person and he has been falsely implicated in this case. He would further submit that the petitioner was found in possession of 1.100 Kgs of ganja, which is below the commercial quantity and hence, he prays for enlargement on bail.

3. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor would submit that the petitioner was found in possession of 1.100 Kgs of ganja, which is below the commercial quantity. He further submitted that the investigation is going on and no case is pending against the petitioner and hence, he prays for dismissal of this application.



4. Considering the rival submissions made by both sides and also considering the fact that the petitioner was found in possession of 1.100 Kgs of ganja, which is below the commercial quantity and he is in custody from 22.09.2011 and the investigation is considerably over, I am inclined to grant bail to the petitioner with certain conditions.

Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate No.I, Mannarkudi, Tiruvarur District, and on further condition that the petitioner shall report before the Court concerned daily at 10.30 a.m. until further orders.
