PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioners apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offences under Sections 147, 341, 323, 294(b), and 506(ii) I.P.C. read with Section 4 of Women Harassment Act in Crime No.386 of 2011 on the file of the respondent police and seek anticipatory bail.

- 2. Heard Mr.R.Ganesan, learned counsel for the petitioners and Mr.C.Ramesh, learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent State.
- 3. The learned counsel for the petitioners would submit in his argument that the petitioners have been falsely implicated in this case. He would further submit that the injured has been discharged from the hospital and no prejudice would be caused to the prosecution in the event of the petitioners release on anticipatory bail.
- 4. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor would submit in his argument that the injured has been discharged from the hospital.

- 5. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and also considering the fact that the injured has been discharged from the hospital, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners with certain conditions.
- WEB (6.) Paccordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate cum Additional District Munsif, Manamadurai, and on executing a separate bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioners shall appear before the Court concerned every day at 10.30 a.m. until further orders. The petitioners shall comply with the condition stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.
 - 7. The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail stands dismissed.
