PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.
ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

This petition has been filed to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner and others are said to have committed offences punishable under Sections 489-A, 489-B, 489-C and 399 read with 120-B of the Indian Penal Code.

3. It is represented on the side of the petitioner that the petitioner has no connection whatsoever with the alleged offences and the petitioner has been falsely implicated merely on the basis of the confession made by one of the accused and now the petitioner is having apprehension of arrest. Under the said circumstances, the present petition has been filed for getting the relief sought for therein.

4. The learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) has submitted the entire case diary for the perusal of the court and the court has perused the same and found that the alleged occurrence has taken place on 29.01.2011 and most of the witnesses have been examined.

5. Considering the stage of investigation and also considering the circumstances under which the present petitioner has been



implicated in the present crime, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

6. In fine, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is granted anticipatory bail subject to the following conditions;

a) the petitioner should execute a bond to the tune of Rs.5,000/- (Rupees five thousand only) and two sureties each for the likesum to the satisfaction of the Judicial Magistrate, Periyakulam;

b) The petitioner shall be released on bail in the event of arrest;

c) The petitioner shall make him available for interrogation by any police officer as and when required;

d) The petitioner shall not indirectly or directly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case, so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to any police officer;

e) The petitioner shall not leave India without any prior permission from the Court;
