PRAYER: Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying for the issuance of a Writ of Mandamus, directing the 2^{nd} respondent to sanction educational loan for 2^{nd} year as well as subsequent years to the petitioner based on the petitioner's application dated 15.12.2009.

ORDER

The petitioner has filed this writ petition for grant of educational loan. In this case, he has already been granted loan for the first year. As far as the second year is concerned, the bank did not disburse the loan amount as the petitioner pointed out that he was in arrear in the first year examination. Hence, the present writ petition has been filed.

- 2.On instructions, learned counsel for the second respondent would bring to the notice of this Court that as per the scheme, he should have produced the progress report as well as the documents which have not been produced to the bank and if the same are produced, they will consider and pass orders in accordance with law.
- 3. Heard the submissions of the learned counsel on either side and perused the materials available on record.
- 4. Taking into consideration the limited prayer made in the write petition and now that the second respondent has also categorically stated that if the petitioner approaches the bank along with relevant documents, they will sanction the loan in accordance with law, suffice to direct the petitioner to approach the bank along with necessary documents and in that event, the bank will pass orders in accordance with the Reserve Bank guideline and norms, within a period of three weeks thereafter.
- 5. With the above direction, the writ petition is disposed of. No costs.
