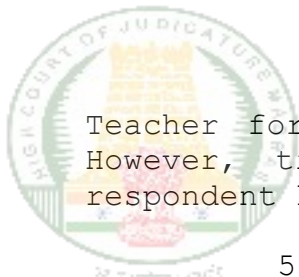
ORDER

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Special Government Pleader appearing for the respondents.

2.By consent of both the parties, the main writ petition itself is taken up for final hearing.

3.The petitioner has come up with the present writ petition for a Mandamus, directing the 3rd respondent to consider the petitioner's representation dated 23.03.2011 within a stipulated time.

4.The case of the petitioner is that she has completed B.Sc., Degree and also completed Teacher Training Course. She had been appointed as Secondary Grade Assistant Teacher in T.D.T.A. Primary and Middle Schools, Melamainanapuram, Tenkasi on 22.01.2010. The appointment was made by the Correspondent of the Diocese of Tirunelveli. The said school is a Government aided school and controlled by Diocese of Tirunelveli. Thereafter, the petitioner's appointment has been approved by the Assistant Elementary Educational Officer. Now, she has been working as a



Teacher for the past 15 months from the date of her appointment. However, till date she has not received any salary. The 3rd respondent has not released the grant for her salary.

5. Seeking such relief, the petitioner has sent a representation dated 23.03.2011 to the 3rd respondent and since the same has not been considered so far, the petitioner has come up with the present writ petition for the relief stated earlier.

6. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, I direct the 3rd respondent to consider the represented dated 23.03.2011, on merits and in accordance with law, within a period of 4 weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

7. The Writ Petition stands disposed of with the aforesaid direction. No costs.
