ORDER

Mr.N.Ilango, Government Advocate takes notice on behalf of the respondents.

- 2. By consent, the Writ Petition is taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission itself.
- 3. Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Special Government Pleader appearing for the respondents.
- 4. The petitioner has come up with the present writ petition praying to direct the respondents to consider and dispose of the petitioner's representation dated 13/8/2010.
- 5. The case of the petitioner is that, he was retired as Sub-Inspector of Police, Kanyakumari District. From Grade-I PC, he was promoted to the https://hcservices.ocourts.govin/hcservices/stable. Without further promotion, he has retired from service on attaining the age of super annuation. He has given several representations to the respondents to adhere the orders made in

- G.O.Ms.No.1681 and G.O.Ms.No.844 for the promotion of Grade I, but the respondents have not obliged the Government Orders. Since Grade I PC Promotion was delayed, in spite of G.Os referred to above, the petitioner had made a representation dated 13/8/2010 to the respondents. Since the same has not been considered so far, the petitioner has approached this Court by way of filing the present Writ Petition.
- 6. Considering the above facts and circumstances, without expressing any opinion on the claim made by the petitioner, I direct the second respondent to consider the representation submitted by the petitioner dated 13/8/2010 and pass appropriate orders on merits and in accordance within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
  - 7. This Writ Petition is ordered accordingly. No costs.
