
O R D E R

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner, Mr.B.Pugalendhi, Special Government Pleader for the respondents 1 and 2 and Mr.M.Govindan for the third respondent.

2. By consent, the main writ petition itself is taken up for final disposal.

3. The petitioner has come up with the present writ petition praying to direct the second respondent to consider his representation dated 20/5/2011 within a stipulated time.

4. The case of the petitioner is that he was appointed as Daily Wage based Assistant in Arumanallur Primary Agricultural Co-operative Bank Ltd on 1/9/1998. Till the month of October 1999, he has been working on Daily Wage basis. The third respondent has resolved a resolution dated



20/12/2006 to regularise his appointment. But, however, the petitioner was not regularised in the service. Hence, the petitioner made a representation dated 20/5/2011 before the second respondent citing G.O.Ms.No.86 Co-operation Food and Consumer Protection (CA2) Department dated 12/3/2011. Even after the receipt of the representation, the second respondent has not considered and passed orders on his representation. Hence, the petitioner has come forward to file the present writ petition.

5. Considering the limited scope of the matter, without expressing any opinion on the claim made by the petitioner, I direct the second respondent to consider the representation submitted by the petitioner dated 20/5/2011 and pass appropriate orders on merits and in accordance with law. The said exercise has to be carried out within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

6. This writ petition is ordered accordingly. No costs.
