## ORDER

Mr.T.S.Mohammed Mohideen, learned Additional Government Pleader, takes notice on behalf of the respondents. By consent, the Writ Petition is taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission itself.

- 2. Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Additional Government Pleader appearing for the respondents.
- 3. The petitioner has come up with the present Writ Petition for a Mandamus, directing the respondents to accord upgradation to him to the post of Special Sub-Inspector of Police on the date of his completion of 25 years of total service along with eligible arrears of pay and allowance from time to time to avoid disparity strictly, in the light of G.O.(Ms) No.15, Home (Police-V) Department, dated 07.01.2010. https://hcservices.ecourts.gov.in/hcservices/

- 4. It is stated by the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner that the petitioner has sent representations to the respondents, which were not considered so far and hence, he has come up with the present Writ Petition for the reliefs stated earlier.
- 5. Considering the limited scope of the matter, without expressing any opinion on the claim made by the petitioner, I direct the petitioner to send a copy of the representation dated 16.05.2011 to the second respondent, within a period of one week from the date of receipt of a copy of this order and on receipt of the same, the second respondent is directed to consider the same and pass appropriate orders on merits and in accordance with law, within a period of eight weeks thereafter.
  - 6. The Writ Petition stands disposed of in the above terms. No costs.
