This writ petition was filed by Sarvasri Vajender Rao and Giri Rao, sons of Sri Bheemsen Rao of Gadwal. Respondents 5, 6 and 7 to this writ petition are Sarvasri Ranga Nayakulu, Pandu Ranganna and Dasaratha Naidu, sons of Sri late Adenna.

2. The dispute concerns around land of an extent of Ac.3-06 gts situate in Survey No.1265, Uppair Village, Dharur Mandal. Learned counsel for the unofficial respondent has drawn my attention to the award dated 05.07.2011 passed in Lok-Adalat Case No.118 of 2011. Paragraph 2 of the award reads as under:

"The respondents 2 to 4 received a sum of Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees One lakh) from the appellants and relinquished their right and claim over Sy.No.1265 of Uppair Village of Dharur Mandal admeasuring Ac.3-05 guntas of land bounded East: Road, West: Land of Musti Bojjanna, South: Land of Chakali Naganna and road leading to Nettempadu, North: Land of Musti Savaranna, in favour of the appellants. The appellants are at liberty to enjoy and cultivate the above mentioned land as absolute owners without any interference from anybody."

3. Sarvasri Vajender Rao and Giri Rao and one

Sri H. Shyam Rao were respondents 2, 3 and 4 in Lok- Adalat Case No.118 of 2011. The unofficial respondents herein are the appellants before the Lok-Adalat Case no.118 of 2011. In view of the award of the Lok-Adalat dated 05.07.2011, it should be construed that the case

in this writ petition does not survive for further adjudication.

4. In that view of the matter, WPMP.No.39438 of 2011 is ordered and the writ petition is disposed of in terms of the award dated 05.07.2011 passed by the Lok-Adalat. No costs.
