

THE HON'BLE SRI JUSTICE RAMESH RANGANATHAN

WRIT PETITION No.14609 of 2011

ORDER:

In this Writ Petition, the action of the respondent, in suspending the permit issued in favour of the petitioner for violation of the permit conditions, is under challenge.

While several grounds are raised in challenge to the impugned order suspending the permit, it is wholly unnecessary for this Court to examine the contentions in as much as both the Learned Counsel for the petitioner and the Learned Government Pleader for Transport would agree that the subject matter of this Writ Petition is covered by an order of this Court in W.P.No.14009 of 2011 dated 11.05.2011, whereby the learned Single Judge, following an earlier order of this Court in W.P.No.3781 of 2011 dated 18.02.2011, restricted the period of suspension of the permit from 30 days to 15 days and made it clear that after expiry of 15 days period, the vehicle would be released to the custody of the petitioner.

Following the aforementioned judgment, and in terms thereof, this Writ Petition is also disposed of restricting the period of suspension of the permit to 15 days. After expiry of 15 days period, the vehicle shall be released to the custody of the petitioner. However, in the circumstances, without costs.
