ORDER:

Petitioners approach this Court with a prayer to quash the

proceedings against them in F.I.R.No.431 of 2011 of Jubilee Hills

Police Station, Hyderabad, whereby they are arrayed as accused for

the offence punishable under Sections 498-A of IPC and 3 and 4 of the

Dowry Prohibition Act.

Heard.

Admittedly, the matter is still at the stage of investigation.

Offence alleged against the petitioners is punishable under Sections

498-A of IPC and 3 and 4 of the D.P.Act. On perusal of the record, this

Court is of the view that this is a matter, which requires to be

investigated into by the Police. As such, this Court is not inclined to

quash the proceedings against the petitioners at this stage.

Learned counsel for the petitioners also submitted that the

petitioners apprehend arrest in the hands of the 1st respondent-Police.

In the present case, the question of identity and custodial interrogation

is not necessary. Hence, the first respondent-Police are directed to

complete the investigation without making arrest of the petitioners.

With the above observation, the Criminal Petition is disposed of.

The miscellaneous petitions, if any, filed along with the criminal

petition shall stand closed.
