**The Court made the following:**

**ORDER:**

This writ petition is filed for the following substantive relief:

“...to issue a writ or order or direction one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus directing the respondent company to bill the electricity charges as per the rates/tariffs generally applicable in the case of 2000-KVA CMD by reducing/derating existing CMD of 8000-KVA to that off the CMD of 2000-KVA and to pass such other order or orders as deemed fit and proper in the circumstances of the case while declaring the inaction of the respondents on the prior intimation given by the petitioner company to reduce the connected contractual load of 8000-KVA to 2000-KVA as illegal, arbitrary and opposed to law.”

Sri V.Sai Kumar, learned counsel for the petitioner, has circulated letter, dated 22.02.2011, to the Registry, wherein it is stated that he has received instructions from his client to withdraw the writ petition.

In view of the same, the writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn.

As a sequel to dismissal of the writ petition, W.P.M.P.No.2264

of 2011 filed by the petitioner for interim relief is disposed of as infructuous.
