Evidently, the non-bailable warrants were issued against the petitioners, who are not present, who stood as sureties, as the accused were absent. Therefore, it cannot be said to be an irregularity on the part of the lower Court in directing the sureties to be present and if they are absent, to issue non-bailable warrants. There is nothing illegal in the order of the lower Court for quashing as desired. If the petitioners are aggrieved, they can surrender before the concerned Court and can move for the bail.

Accordingly, the Criminal Petition is dismissed. Consequently, Crl.M.P.No.4422 of 2011 is also dismissed.
