ORDER:

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner, as well as the learned standing counsel for the respondents.

Petitioner has given on hire his vehicle to the respondent Corporation in terms of the agreement entered into between them dated 07.08.2008. After allowing the agreement to operate for some time, the petitioner sought withdrawal of the bus on the ground that on account of financial problems, he is unable to run the vehicle, and made a

representation to the respondent Corporation on 27.05.2011, followed by another representation dated 31.05.2011. Petitioner submits that in spite of circular instructions of the Corporation on the subject and petitioner's undertaking to comply with the said circular instructions, no orders are being passed by the respondents.

The learned standing counsel for the respondents submits that if the petitioner complies with the requirement of the circular instructions issued by the A.P.S.R.T.C in proceedings No.P9/259(100)/2003-OPD(PLG) dated 25.07.2006, the petitioner's request for release of the vehicle will be considered.

In view of the subject matter of the petitioner's grievance being fully covered by the circular of the respondent Corporation dated 25.07.2006, the 2nd respondent shall consider the petitioner's request in terms of the said circular, and if the petitioner complies with the terms of the said circular, pass appropriate orders for release of the vehicle. This exercise shall be completed within four weeks from today.

The Writ Petition is accordingly disposed of. No order as to costs.
