Minor Mineral Concession Rules, 1966 (for brevity "the Rules") as illegal and arbitrary and for a consequential direction to release the lorries pending enquiry by the District Committee.

authorized by the District Collector to take action in terms of Rules

9-X and 26 of the Rules.

stage. No order as to costs.
