HON'BLE SRI JUSTICE A. GOPAL REDDY <u>CIVIL REVISION PETITION No.4802 of 2011</u> ORDER: -

The docket order, dated 01.03.2011, passed by the learned Principal District Judge, Krishna Machilipatnam in I.A.No.2 of 2010 in I.A.No.55 of 2009 in T.A.S.No.2 of 2004, condoning the delay of 1350 days in filing the petition to set aside the abatement caused for not bringing the legal representatives, without any reasons, cannot be sustained. From the docket order it cannot be understood as to what is passing in the mind of the learned District Judge. In view of the same, after hearing both the parties, I deem that it is a fit case to remand the matter to the lower court for fresh disposal. Accordingly, the impugned order is set aside and the lower court is directed to dispose of the I.A. by giving a reasoned order.

The Civil Revision Petition is, accordingly, allowed and the matter is remanded to the lower court for fresh disposal. No order as to costs.
