ORDER:

This writ petition is filed for the following substantive relief:

“....to issue any Writ, Order or Direction, more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, directing the Respondents to pay the amounts along with EMD, FSD & Income Tax noted in MBs bearing Nos:030/AH/08-09; 052/AH/08-09; 051/AH/08-09; 050/AH/08-09; 049/AH/08-09; 053/AH/08-09; 044/AH/08-09; 045/AH/08-09 & 1520/AH/08-09 and to pass such other or other orders...”

On 23.02.2011, there was no appearance for the parties and, therefore, the case was adjourned. Even today, at the hearing, the petitioner is unrepresented. It is, therefore, reasonable to presume that the petitioner is not interested in pursuing his cause in the writ petition.

The Writ Petition is, therefore, dismissed for non-prosecution.
