The application stands allowed and the document is taken on record.

MAIN CASE

This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing FIR No.58 dated 12.03.2010 under Section 498-A, 406, 506, 509 of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station DLF Phase-II, District Gurgaon, on the basis of compromise, along with all subsequent proceedings arising from that FIR.

Vide order dated 21.02.2011, this Court directed the Illaqua Magistrate to record the statements of parties to know about the genuineness of the compromise. A cheque of ₹ 10 lacs was also handed over the counsel for the complainant on that date.

Report of the trial Court has been received in which it is mentioned that parties have arrived at a compromise and the compromise is genuine. Learned counsel for the complainant is also present in Court and has admitted the factum of compromise. It is a matrimonial dispute which has been amicably settled.

So, in view of the above circumstances and in view of authority reported as, "**Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and others**" 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, the above said FIR stands quashed. Further proceedings in pursuant to that FIR also stands quashed.
