The case of the petitioners is that they are major and have contracted marriage on 28.11.2011. The marriage certificate and the photographs evidencing marriage have been placed on the file. It is alleged that they apprehend danger from respondents No.4 and 5.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Amandeep Singh, AAG, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice.

Without commenting on the age of the petitioners and validity of the marriage, directions are given to the Superintendent of Police, Sirsa to decide the representation of the petitioners, if any filed within one week from today, within one month from the date of receipt of representation, keeping in view the threat perception to the petitioners.

However, it is made clear that in case any criminal case is pending against the petitioners, this order shall not debar the respondents to proceed with.

The petition stands disposed of.
