Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that in the head note at Sr. No. 3, inadvertently "Station House Officer, P.S Focal Point, District Mansa" has been mentioned instead of "District Ludhiana". Prayer has been made for correcting the same.

The prayer stands allowed and necessary correction is ordered to be made in the head note.

The case of the petitioners is that they are major and have contracted marriage on 28.11.2011. The marriage certificate and the photographs evidencing marriage have been placed on the file. It is alleged that they apprehend danger from

respondents No.4 and 5. To seek redressal of their grievance, they have submitted representation dated 28.11.2011 (Annexure P-5) to the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana.

Notice of motion to Advocate General, Punjab.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Simsi Dhir Malhotra, AAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice.

Without commenting on the age of the petitioners and validity of the marriage, directions are given to the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, to decide the representation of the petitioners (Annexure P-5) within one month from today, keeping in view the threat perception to the petitioners.

However, it is made clear that in case any criminal case is pending against the petitioners, this order shall not debar the respondents to proceed with.

The petition stands disposed of.
