## Surya Kant, J. (Oral)

The petitioner seeks a mandamus for her appointment as Teaching Fellow against the unfilled posts of reserved category of Physically Challenged persons. The above stated relief has been sought on the basis of the Government Instructions dated 2.5.1997 (Annexure P-6). Reliance is also placed on a decision of this Court dated 12.1.2011 in *Civil Writ Petition No12886 of 2010 (Jagjit Kaur and others versus State of Punjab and others* (Annexure P-9) whereby the claim of similarly placed persons is said to have been accepted.

In these circumstances and without expressing any views on the merits of the petitioner's claim, I deem it appropriate to dispose of this writ petition with a direction to the respondents to consider and dispose of the above-mentioned claim of the petitioner in the light of <u>Jagjit Kaur's</u> <u>case</u> (supra) and in case she is found entitled, to give her appointment within a period of <u>four months</u> from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order.

Ordered accordingly.
