By means of this writ petition, moved under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, the petitioners have sought quashing of the first information report dated 23.06.2011, registered as F.I.R. No. 152 of 2011, relating to offences punishable under Section 452, 323, 504, 506 of I.P.C., at police station Gangnagar, District Haridwar.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that after the petitioners' father, who was tenant in the house of the husband of the complainant filed a civil suit. The impugned first information report has been lodged by the complainant as a counterblast. On the other hand, learned counsel for the complainant pleaded that the complainant has suffered injuries, and the first information report is supported by injury report.

In the above circumstances, this court is of the view that it is not a fit case for interference with the investigation.

Therefore, the writ petition is dismissed summarily with the observation that if the petitioners, namely Sachin and Amit surrender before the court concerned, their bail application shall be heard and disposed of without unreasonable delay.
