ORDER 31.01.2011

This petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C has been preferred by the petitioner for reduction of number of surety amount as well as number of surety.

The petitioner was earlier granted bail by the trial court on furnishing one surety. However, the petitioner jumped the bail. In the second order, the trial court asked for two sureties as petitioner at earlier occasion gave surety bond of co-accused. I have asked the counsel for the petitioner as to how much amount was involved in the case and according to him around Rs.15 lac was involved. The petitioner is involved in a case under Prevention of Corruption Act and cheating both. A person who procured amount to that extent, if is ordered to be released on furnishing two sureties of Rs.1 lac each, I do not consider that the order passed by learned trial court was not according to law or harsh.

I find no force in this petition. The petition is hereby dismissed.
