read with Sections 434 and 439 of the Companies Act, 1956.

Mr. Ankit Shah, learned counsel for the respondent-company,
on instructions of Mr. Sanjiv Gupta, Vice President of the respondent-
company, states that in a bid to amicably resolve the matter,
respondent-company is willing to pay a sum of ₹ 2,78,976/- to the
petitioner-company.

Mr. C.S. Gupta, learned counsel for petitioner-company, on instructions of Mr. Sajiv Thapar, Managing Director of the petitioner-company, states that petitioner is willing to accept the aforesaid sum in full and final settlement of respondent's debt.

Keeping in view the aforesaid statements, present petition is disposed of as satisfied with a direction to the Registrar General to prepare an account payee cheque in favour of the petitioner-company for a sum of ₹ 2,78,976/- from the amount deposited by the respondent-company in Co. Pet. 351/2009.
