Plaintiffs/respondents filed a suit for permanent and mandatory injunction in respect of property in dispute against defendants/appellants, which was decreed by the trial Court.

2. Being aggrieved with the same, an appeal was preferred by the defendants, which has been dismissed by the First Appellate Court vide judgment and decree dated 05.04.2008, which is under challenge in this second appeal, preferred on behalf of defendants.

3. Controversial issues involved in the case are relating to question of facts and there is concurrent finding of facts recorded by both the Courts below. Learned counsel for appellants could not point out any illegality

or perversity in the finding of the Courts below.

4. No substantial question of law is involved in this second appeal and the same is, accordingly, dismissed in limine.
