BY THE COURT:

The application for early listing of the writ petition is allowed. With consent of the parties, matter is heard finally.

It is stated that this matter is covered by the judgment of this court in the case of “Smt Yasmeen Bano & ors Vs Panchayati Raj & ors”, SB Civil Writ Petition No. 8908/2010, decided on 28.9.2010. The issue therein was regarding late receiving of call letter for interview to the post of Prabodhak.

Aforesaid statement of learned counsel for petitioner has not been contested by learned counsel for respondents.

In the light of the aforesaid, this writ petition is

disposed of with a direction that this case would be governed by the judgment (supra). Operative portion of the judgment aforesaid is quoted hereunder for compliance by the respondents -

“In view of the aforesaid, these writ petitions are disposed of with the direction to the respondents for issuance of call letters to those candidates who have received call letters subsequent to the dates fixed for interview. It goes without saying that such call letters would be sent to the candidates in advance so that they may appear before the Interview Board for interview on the dates now to be fixed. Necessary steps in that regard shall be taken within shortest possible time as agreed by the learned Addl. Advocate General.

In view of the directions aforesaid, the writ petitions stand disposed of. After interviews, if the petitioners are found suitable, eligible and meritorious, they would be given consequential benefits by issuing appropriate order.”
