BY THE COURT:

Learned counsel for petitioners submits that pursuant to the interim order of this court, petitioners were given admission in the B Ed course which has been completed by them and marks sheets have also been issued to them. The controversy was only with regard to the cut off date for passing the qualifying examination. It is stated that cut off date was altered as 2.8.2009 and before the said date, result of qualifying examination of the petitioners was declared.

In the light of aforesaid, petitioners were eligible to undertake B Ed course, which, in fact, they have already undertaken and result has also been declared thus writ petition has become infructuous and same is dismissed as such. However, it is observed that petitioners having qualified the B Ed course, no impediment would be created on the aforesaid qualification.
