It is contended on behalf of the appellant that looking to the short term of sentence, the learned trial court itself has suspended the sentence of the appellant for one month, disposal of the appeal is likely to take time, therefore, It will be just, proper and in the interest of justice that the sentence of imprisonment of the appellant awarded by the trial court is suspended during pendency of the appeal.

3. After considering all the facts and circumstances of the case, but without

expressing any opinion on merits and demerits of the case, I am inclined to allow this application and the same is hereby allowed.

4. It is directed that sentence of imprisonment of appellant namely Sumant Chatterji S/o. Late Shri Pooran Chand Chatterji passed by Special Judge, ACD, Jaipur vide impugned judgment dated 14.07.2011 in Criminal Case No. 15/1993 shall remain suspended during pendency of this appeal and he shall be released on bail provided, he furnishes a personal bond in the sum of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousands) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the trial court to appear before this Court on 29.08.2011 and as and when he is called upon to do so.
