**ORAL ORDER**


3 31-05-2012 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned counsel for the State.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that during the pendency of this bail application, petitioner no. 3, namely, Narayan Paswan has already been arrested. Hence he may be permitted to withdraw the bail application against petitioner no. 3.

Permission is granted.

The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in connection with Dalsingsarai P.S. Case No. 108 of 2010, registered under Sections 304 B and 201 of the Indian Penal Code.

However, the police after investigation submitted Final Form against these petitioners. However, C.J.M. took cognizance against the petitioners.
