

ORAL ORDER

2 30-03-2012 Petitioner being husband is apprehending his arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 498A, 323, 307/34 of the I.P.C. and Section 3/4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act.

Accusations are of torture and attempt to kill the informant.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that no injury was caused and petitioner is ready to keep the informant as wife with full dignity and honour.

Considering the aforesaid stand of the parties, let the petitioner namely Munna Kumar Bharti, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of 12 weeks from today, be released on provisional anticipatory bail for one year, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the

satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Saran at Chapra in connection with Daudpur P.S. Case No. 94 of 2011.

Let learned Court below issue notice to the informant and fix a date for her appearance. On appearance of the informant, the petitioner will take the informant to her matrimonial house to keep her as wife with full dignity and honour.

The provisional anticipatory bail of the petitioner will be confirmed by the learned Court below on substantial restoration of the matrimonial harmony within a period of one year, or the informant deliberately refuses to reside with the petitioner.
