ORAL ORDER

2 29-02-2012 Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned counsel for the State.

The petitioner is an accused in connection with Kishanganj P.S. Case No.358/2011 for the offence punishable under Sections 457, 380 and 411 of the I.P.C.

It is submitted that the FIR was lodged against unknown.

During investigation on the confessional statement of the petitioner, some of the stolen articles have been recovered from the possession of the co-accused. Nothing has been recovered from the possession of the petitioner. The petitioner has no criminal antecedent. The petitioner has been in custody since 28.08.2011.

Learned counsel for the State could not controvert the contention of the learned counsel for the petitioner while opposing

his prayer for bail.

Considering the facts and circumstances of this case, the above-named petitioner is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Kishanganj in connection with Kishanganj P.S. Case No.358/2011 with the following conditions :

1. One of the bailors will be the close relative of the petitioner.
2. The petitioner will not indulge in similar or in any other offence.
3. The petitioner will appear before the court on each and every date fixed in the case except for any cogent reason.
4. In case of absence for two consecutive dates or in case of violation of the terms of the bail, his bail bond will be liable to be cancelled by the concerned court and he will be taken into custody forthwith.
