Earlier prayer for bail of the petitioner was rejected by this court vide order dated 24.1.2012 passed in Cr. Misc. no. 37320/2011 but submission on behalf of the petitioner is that the informant has already entered into compromise and his statement has already been recorded in course of trial. It is further contended that informant has not supported the prosecution case in his cross-examination.

The learned trial court has reported that altogether five prosecution witnesses have already been examined and only seven prosecution witnesses including Investigating officer and the doctor are left to be examined.

Learned trial court vide letter dated 9.7.2012 has sought four months' time to conclude the trial of the petitioner.

In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances as well as submissions of the parties, I am not inclined to release the petitioner on bail.

Accordingly, his prayer for bail in connection with Kawakole P.S. Case no. 44/2010 arising out of Sessions trial no. 104 of 2012/30 of 2012 pending in the court of Addl. Sessions Judge(Adhoc) III, Nawada is

again rejected.

However, the learned trial court is directed to conclude the trial of the petitioner within four months from 9.7.2012 and if the same is not concluded with the above stated period, the learned trial court shall release the petitioner on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to his satisfaction.
