

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and  
learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

Petitioner is one of the named accused in this case being owner of the vehicle from where in two bags, 7 Kgs of each, altogether 14 Kgs, of ganja were recovered. Submission is of false implication on mere suspicion and vehicle in question was of commercial one and the passenger, on arrival at the destination, seeing the Police, fled away leaving the commodities inside which was recovered. Petitioner has no concern with the same and he is in custody having no criminal antecedent.

If it is so, the petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the **Sessions Judge, Saharsa, in Supaul P.S.**  
**Case no. 192 of 2012 (Spl. Case no. 02 of 2012)** with the



condition that the petitioner shall remain present before court below on each and every date till disposal of the case. In the event of failure to attend the court on two consecutive dates without any reasonable explanation, the privilege granted shall be deemed to be cancelled.
