2      19-12-2012                      Heard learned counsels for the petitioner  
and the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in  
a case registered for the offences punishable under  
Sections 419, 420, 341, 323, 384 and 504/34 of the  
Indian Penal Code.

The accusation against the petitioner is of  
demanding Rs. 1,000/- for providing electric  
connection.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the  
petitioner that the petitioner is not the employee  
of the Bihar Electricity Board. A statement has been  
made in paragraph no. 13 of the petition that the  
petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

Considering the aforesaid facts, let the  
petitioner, above named, be released on bail in the  
event of arrest or surrender before the learned

court below within a period of twelve weeks from today in connection with Khodabanpur (Chaurahi) P.S. Case No. 100 of 2011 on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned C.J.M. Begusarai, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
