7. 31-01-2012 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the Opposite parties.

The petitioner seeks initiation of contempt against the Opposite parties for non compliance of this Court's order dated 18.2.2008 passed in C.W.J.C. No. 12118 of 2007 by which this Court had directed the Registrar/Finance Officer of the University to look into the representation of the petitioner and make payment of admitted dues as also interest of 5% on delayed payments.

Show cause and supplementary show cause have

been filed on behalf of L.N. Mithila University and in paragraphs-3 and 4 of the show cause and in paragraphs-4, 5 and 7, the details of payments have been mentioned as also that the representation has been disposed of with the reasoned order.

In view of such, I am not inclined to proceed with the matter any further.

The counsel for the petitioner at this juncture, submits that he be given liberty to raise his ancillary grievances before an appropriate forum.

The application is disposed off with liberty to the petitioner to raise his fresh grievances before an appropriate forum which may be considered appropriately.
