
Heard learned counsels for the petitioner  
and the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in  
a case registered for the offences punishable under  
Sections 419 and 420/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

It is alleged that in the examination of  
IBPS, one Sonu Kumar was appearing in place of this  
petitioner.

It is submitted that the petitioner has no  
knowledge about appearing in the said examination in  
his place. It is further submitted that non-grant of  
anticipatory bail to the petitioner will jeopardize  
the career of the petitioner.

Considering the aforesaid facts, let the  
petitioner, above named, be released on bail in the  
event of arrest or surrender before the learned  
court below within a period of twelve weeks from  
today in connection with Pirbahor P.S. Case No. 168



of 2012 on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned C.J.M. Patna, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
