Petitioner is the owner of a truck bearing Registration No.CG04HA-3565 which was the subject matter of Confiscation Case No.14/2010 and has also been confiscated under order dated 15.12.2011, Annexure-5. This writ petition has been filed for a direction to the respondents to release the aforesaid truck. Against the confiscation order petitioner filed appeal which has been numbered as Confiscation Appeal No.01/2011-12 pending before the Collector, Munger.

Let Collector, Munger consider the appeal and dispose of the same in accordance with law as early as possible, in any case within two months from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order. It is made clear that if appellate authority does not dispose of the appeal within the time indicated in this order, he may expose himself to the contempt proceeding of this Court.

4. The writ petition is, accordingly, disposed of.
