

Heard learned counsels for the petitioners and the State.

The petitioners are apprehending arrest in a complaint case in which cognizance has been taken under Sections 420 and 468 of the Indian Penal Code.

It is alleged against petitioner no. 1 to have executed a sale deed with regard to the land of the complainant in favour of petitioner no. 4 when petitioner nos. 2, 3 and 5 are witnesses to the sale deed and accusation of conspiracy has been levelled against petitioner no. 6.

It is submitted that petitioner no. 1 is the agnate of the complainant and she has transferred the land of her share.

It is submitted by the learned counsel for the complainant that petitioner no. 1 is not the agnate of the complainant and earlier also the complainant lodged a case against

the husband of petitioner no. 1.

Considering the accusation arising out of civil dispute between the parties, let the above named petitioners be released on anticipatory bail in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of twelve weeks from today on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Khagaria in connection with Complaint case no. 107 C of 2012 subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
