

Heard learned counsels for the petitioner
and the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in
a case registered for the offences punishable under
Sections 272, 273 of the Indian Penal Code and 47(a)
of the Excise Act.

12000 sachets of country made liquor were
recovered from the pick-up van when the petitioner
was identified as the person fleeing away from the
place of occurrence when it was suspected by the
prosecution that the petitioner was driver.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the
petitioner that on suspicion, accusation has been
levelled. It is further submitted seizure was made
on 11.08.2012 when the prosecution report was
transmitted to the learned court below on
13.08.2012. The statement has been made in paragraph
no. 8 of the petition that the petitioner has no



criminal antecedent.

Considering the aforesaid facts, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of twelve weeks from today in connection with Jagdishpur P.S. Case No. 134 of 2012 on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned C.J.M. Bhojpur at Ara, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
