

ORAL ORDER**

2 28-09-2012 Heard learned counsels for the petitioner and the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 406, 409, 420 and 120B/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

It is alleged that one Ashok Paswan persuaded the informant to get loan under B.P.L. scheme on assurance that loan amount will be subsequently liquidated. In the F.I.R., the accusation has been levelled against Ashok Paswan and six others. It is alleged against this petitioner that he asked the informant to put the signature on some paper. Subsequently, the informant was offered only Rs. 30,000/- against the sanction loan Rs. 1,00,000/-.

It is submitted that Ashok Paswan @ Indradeo



Paswan has been granted regular bail by this Court vide Cr. Misc. No. 1050 of 2012.

This Court sees no reason for the learned court below not to give the same privilege to the petitioner if he surrenders within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order in connection with Maranchi P.S. Case No. 73 of 2011 pending in the court of the learned A.C.J.M., Barh, Patna. It is expected that regular bail application of the petitioner shall be disposed off by the learned court below preferably on the same day.

With this observation, the application is disposed off.

Let the order be faxed to the learned court below at the cost of the petitioner.
