Heard Mr. SC Biswas, learned counsel for the petitioners. Also heard Mr. BB Gogoi, learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

This bail application under section 438 Cr.P.C. has been filed by the petitioners, namely, Siraz Uddin Laskar, Shorif Uddin Laskar @ Sarif Uddin Laskar, Shiboth Ali Laskar @ Shipat Ali Laskar @ Md. Shipoth Ali Laskar, Sahab Uddin Laskar @ Sabul Uddin Laskar, Sahid Ahmed Laskar @ Sahid Uddin Laskar and Shohid Ali Laskar praying for anticipatory bail apprehending their arrest in connection with Silchar Police Station Case No. 609 of 2012 (GR No. 1095 of 2012) under section 143/447/342/384/323 IPC. Perused the FIR and other documents.

The accused persons were granted bail on 27.4.2012 in BA No.909 of 2012.

In the aforesaid order, it has been observed that the matter relates to boundary dispute and both the parties are related to each other.

Today, the learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the petitioners are a teacher of NIT, Bank employees etc.

Considering all the aspects, prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioners is accepted.

Accordingly, the I.O. is directed to release the petitioners in the event of their arrest on furnishing bail of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) each with one local surety of like amount to the satisfaction of the arresting authority.

The petitioners are directed to appear before the I.O.s and when required for interrogation.

With the aforesaid directions, this anticipatory bail application stands disposed of.
