

Heard Mr HRA Choudhury, learned senior counsel for the petitioners. Also heard Mr BS Sinha, learned Addl. PP, Assam who has produced the case diary.

The case diary reveals that the victim Md Faijul Haque died due to internal haemorrhage of the stomach and there is no indication of any external injury mark on the body and the said deceased died after a week of his visit to the house of the present petitioners and no evidence has come up indicating any physical assault by the petitioners.

In view of the above, present petition is allowed. The petitioners, namely, 1) Md. Mamud Ali 2) Md Amsar Ali and 3) Md. Jamshed Ali, in the event of their arrest in connection with Mayang PS Case No.89/2012 (Corresponding to GR Case No.973/2012) under sections 342/326/302/34 IPC, shall be enlarged on bail on execution of bond of Rs.15,000/- each, with one surety of the like amount to the satisfaction of the arresting authority.
