

Heard Mr. M. Sarania, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. J. Handique, learned State counsel appearing for all the respondents.

This writ petition is filed praying for a direction to hand over the investigation of Basistha P.S. Case No.664/10 under Section 365/368/364-A, IPC to C.I.D.

Today, Mr. J. Handique, learned State counsel has submitted a Progress Report of investigation. On perusal of the said Progress Report, it is seen that the Sr. Superintendent of Police, Guwahati, has requested the Director General of Police, Assam on 10.2.2012 to issue necessary direction to the Criminal Investigation Department (CID), Assam, to take over investigation of the case for its logical conclusion.

Mr. Handique, learned State counsel submits that all necessary formalities is likely to be completed within 10 days' time.

In view of the aforesaid, Mr. M. Sarania, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he would not like to press this application. He, however, prays for liberty to approach this Court in case necessity arises.

Accordingly, the writ petition stands disposed of. The learned counsel for the petitioner, is, however, granted liberty to approach this Court in case necessity arises on account of slackness of investigation.

The Progress Report is kept in a sealed cover and placed on the record of this Case.
