04. 31.08.2012. From perusal of Annexure 5, it seems that the petitioner has secured 132 marks in the written examination while he has secured 10 marks in the interview. Annexure 5 further reveals that a candidate, for selection, is required to secure minimum 110 marks in the written examination while 14 marks in the interview.

Since the petitioner could secure only 10 marks in the interview, therefore, he was not able to secure cut off "14" marks in interview and was not selected. Even otherwise also, information under the Right to Information Act, Annexure 5 was received by the petitioner on 22.12.2011 while the present writ petition was filed in the month of July, 2012. All the appointments were made in the month of August, 2011. Therefore, entertaining this writ petition after almost one year from the date of the result would not be proper. Moreover, the petitioner has failed to explain the laches.

The writ petition is devoid of merit and it is, accordingly, dismissed.
