02/21.12.2012. Bail application filed by Bikash Mandal is moved by Sri R.S.Majumdar, learned Sr. counsel for the petitioner and opposed by Sri. S.S.Prasad, Addl P.P. for the State.

It appears that informant Durga Charan Mandal, who is the father of deceased had not supported the case of prosecution and has been declared hostile. Likewise, other witnesses who were examined as PW 1, 2 & 3 had also not supported the case of prosecution. The allegation against the petitioner is simpler to other co-accused Shibu Mandal and Bhawani Mandal who have been granted bail vide Order dated 18.06.2012 in B.A. No. 87 of 2012.

Considering the aforesaid fact and circumstance and taking into account that petitioner is in custody from 11.06.2010, I allow this application and direct the court below to enlarge the petitioner, named above, on bail, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned District & Additional Sessions Judge-II, Dhanbad in connection with S.T. No. 83 of 2011.
