The order of cancellation of allotment is under challenge in the present writ application relating to the Jharkhand State Housing Board.

Learned counsel for the respondent, however, submits that issue relating to the cancellation of such matter of allotment have been earlier raised before this Court and the writ petitions were dismissed and the matters have reached its finality pursuant to the judgment and order dated 15.06.2012 passed in LPA NO. 380 of 2010 and LPA No. 383 of 2010, copies of which annexed to the counter affidavit (Annexure-C).

It is submitted on behalf of the counsel for the respondents-Board that allotment made at a relevant point of time in a series of transaction have been cancelled as the same were made in the illegal manner without following any procedure by one Executive Engineer Housing Board and such cancellation of allotments have been agitated before the Court hereinabove and achieved finality and therefore, no interference should be made in such matter where original order of allotment itself was done in illegal and arbitrary manner without following procedure.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is not in position to

dispute the same.

In view of the specific stand taken by the respondent as also brought on record by way of counter affidavit and the judgment rendered by the Division Bench in the LPA referred hereinabove (Supra), this writ petition is also devoid of merit and accordingly, this writ petition is dismissed.
